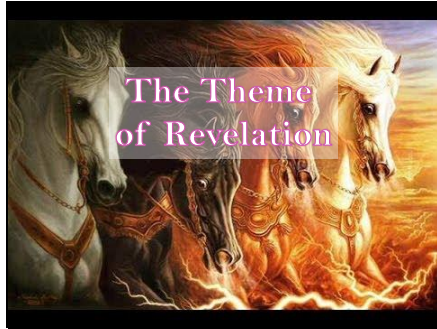

Those Who Pierced Him

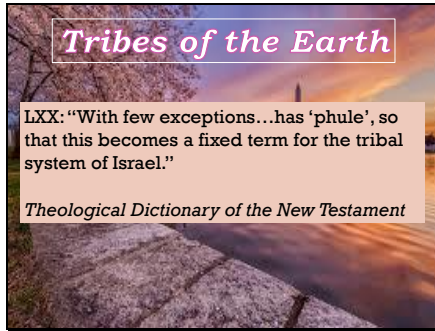

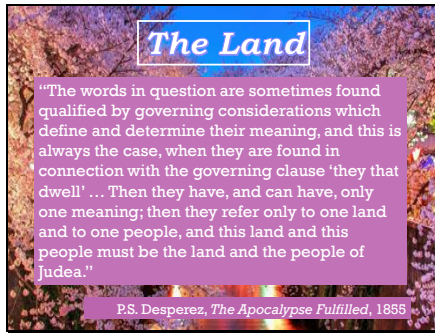
Those Who Pierced Him
